### **New Evidence Revealed in 28 Year Old Murder Case**

Dateline NBC will air a special 2 hour feature exploring the innocence of Montana inmate Barry Beach, Friday, March 21st at 8:00 PM (MST), according to Bob Kolar, spokesman for Montanans for Justice (MFJ). “We are excited to see this NBC Special air,” stated Mr. Kolar. “Hopefully the NBC documentary will bring out the truth regarding this travesty of justice against an innocent man. “The case against Barry Beach is nonsense and an outrage to all who have taken the time to investigate the case,” said Kolar. Montanans for Justice is working to free Mr. Beach who, they feel, has been wrongly convicted. Beach is currently serving 100 years without the possibility of parole, for the murder of 17 year old Kim Nees at Poplar, Montana in 1979.

Dateline NBC has been in Montana for over a year looking into all sides of this case. Their reporters and investigators have interviewed witnesses in Poplar as well as other parts of Montana, including filming of parts of the Probation and Parole hearing held last year in Deer Lodge.
