JOEL SPARVIER having been called as a witness on behalf of the Defendant, 5 and being first duly sworn upon his oath, testified as 6 follows: 7 By Mr. Moses: 8 Would you state your name please? Q 9 My name is Joel Sparvier. Α 10 Q Mr. Sparvier, where do you live? West of Poplar. 11 Α And are you the son of Maybelle Sparvier? 12 Q 13 Yes I am.
